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Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of the completion of the coursework element of A Level Geography, we intend to take Year 12 on a residential fieldtrip to a Geography fieldwork academy centre located in Southwold, Suffolk. The purpose of this trip is to plan, carry out and begin to analyse fieldwork data which is for their independent fieldwork investigation; this is worth 20% of their A Level.

We will leave school at 7.45am on Monday 17th July and arrive back at approximately 5.00pm on Wednesday 19th July 2023.

On day one there will be an introduction to the issues within Southwold. These will range from the impact of climate change, coastal management, gentrification, changing places and the impact of geology on coastal recession. Students will experiment with new forms of data collection during the fieldwork and develop a sense of place in the town and on the beach. In the evening, students work independently to design their fieldwork titles and aims. Students will create their own bespoke fieldwork data collection booklets.

On day two students will carry out their data collection and in the late afternoon are taught a session demonstrating GIS and the application of statistical tests to their data collected.

On the final day, students have a second opportunity to gather data from Southwold, based on their refinements from the evening before.

The cost will be £200 which includes the expertise of the tutors at the fieldwork academy, transport, accommodation and food in the youth hostel we will stay in Blaxhall, Suffolk. Students are also advised to bring their own spending money for any additional things they might want to buy, approximately £40 should be adequate.

I would be grateful if you could pay £100 by **17th February 2023** with the final payment of £100 to be paid by **Friday 12th May 2023**, alternatively please feel free to pay the full total. Please go to www.parentpay.com and pay and complete the permission for your child to attend. Should you require financial support please do contact the school for further details (jashton@northleamington.co.uk). It is advisable that students do not take valuables on this trip. However, if it is necessary, please ensure that your own insurance covers such items.

Educational site visits are an additional opportunity for students to support their learning. Should we have any concerns regarding a student's behaviour, either prior to or in the time between signing up to the trip, that student will be withdrawn from the trip and individual parents will be notified accordingly. Any monies paid will be non-refundable unless a suitable replacement can be found and in this instance, a refund will be issued minus any deposit paid.

A further letter will be sent in the summer term with final arrangements for this residential fieldtrip. I hope these arrangements meet with your approval. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
