Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to introduce myself as your child's Year Lead from September. I will be responsible for both their pastoral care and their academic progress as they embark on their educational journey at North Leamington School.

Parents/ Carers and teachers have a collective goal to provide our young people with the qualities, standards and skills that will enable them to thrive and contribute positively to society. Within my role, I will be tracking and monitoring attendance, achievement and the behaviour of your child to ensure that successes are recognised and celebrated, and any concerns are addressed promptly. These staff members will support me, as Year Lead, by ensuring they play an active role in supporting your child with their academic and pastoral wellbeing. These staff members will be the first point of communication between yourselves and the school. There will be challenges and triumphs ahead and it is my role, with my team of Form Tutors, to support your child to make the most of their time in school and be the best that they can be.

Each tutor group has a College identity - Binswood, Blackdown, Croft, Manor, and Park. As College members, your child will take part in a range of exciting opportunities from leadership and assemblies, to charity events and sports day. College competitions take place throughout the year and, in some cases, will allow for collaboration with other students across all year groups.
