Year 7 German Curriculum Overview

Rationale for year group & skills: German students will undertake 3 lessons per fortnight. They will study the topics of introducing themselves, family and pets and free-time. We aim to make language learning a positive and rewarding experience and aim to support our students in gaining a greater knowledge and understanding of different cultures and customs in German-speaking countries. We hope to equip them with the language skills required to enable them to communicate effectively. In Year 7, students will develop their confidence as well as their communication and teamwork skills, as they will regularly work in pairs or small groups.

Listening – Our students will need to demonstrate understanding of main points, opinions and some details in short passages which include reference to either the present or the future. They will transcribe short phrases.

Writing – Our students will need to write short texts for different purposes using mainly memorised language, referring to the present or the future, express opinions and give simple reasons. They will translate simple sentences containing familiar words and structures into the target language. Generally accurate in using straightforward language and meaning is clear, but there may be errors with verbs.

Homework set from homework booklet or vocabulary: words based on the previous lessons or in preparation for the next lessons.

Revise twice or three times per week in 10-15 minute slots to be able to remember words.

How to revise:

- a. Look, cover, write / say aloud, check method.
- b. Get somebody at home to test you and check your answers.
- c. Make flashcards and test yourself English on one side / German on the back.
