



## Year 8 Curriculum Overview – Cultural Patterns Table Setting

**Rationale:** The Year 8 curriculum is designed to build on skills taught in Y7.

**They will study patterns from different cultures around the world, such as African Wax Patterns, Aboriginal dot paintings, Japanese repeat patterns and Scottish Tartan. This will include a chance for students to experiment with a range different techniques and processes; batik, press print, mark-making and weave. This will be brought together in design work to enable students to complete an outcome of a place mat and coaster.**
