Dear Parent/ Carers,

I am writing to inform you that your child has the opportunity to visit Coventry University for a Sports Experience Day on Tuesday 17 December. The day is designed to give students the opportunity to understand the contents of their A-level course in practice and experience possibly studying sport beyond the Sixth Form at university. Students will have the opportunity to get involved in sessions relating to Sports Coaching, Sport and Exercise Science and Sports and Exercise Therapy, learning the similarities and differences between the courses and identifying potential future career pathways. It will include a range of 45-minute sessions, led by some of their experts in Sport, exploring some of the state-of-the-art sports equipment schools do not have access to.

We will leave school at 11.15am and return to School for 4pm, travelling by school minibus. Students should bring a packed lunch, or sufficient money to purchase lunch during the day.

Students need to come to school that day in suitable sports clothing to take part in practical sessions during the day.
