University Open Days – Leave of Absence Requests

Part of the process of deciding their future pathways will of course involve students wishing to attend university or college open days and we are supportive of this *in principle*. Further to previous communications, please recall that:

- Any request for a planned absence for such things requires a parent to complete a Leave of Absence Request Form
- Please be aware that NLS may only be able to consent to such requests for Open Days if the college or university does not offer the Open Day at a weekend or in school holiday time –the vast majority of organisations do

We are sure you will understand the reasoning: studying for the qualifications (especially in the immediate run-up to end-of-year Progression Exams) needs to be the priority and especially where there are alternative dates available which do not get in the way of study.

Dress Code

Please recall the agreed Dress Code for the Sixth Form, it takes a collective effort to ensure full adherence. Please, then, continue to ensure your child respects it so that we can continue to offer a balance between creative freedom of expression and role-modelling for other students.
