Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of A Level Geography, we intend to take Year 12 Geographers on a field trip to Grantchester on Friday 4 October 2024. The purpose of the visit is to experience first-hand a case study that is part of the Changing Spaces, Making Places topic. Students will also have the opportunity to collect primary data and carry out a focus group with key village residents. This will aid students in their understanding of fieldwork techniques, which is a component of the coursework. They will also visit the Sedgewick Museum in Cambridge, which will support both the Coasts and Hazards topics that occur later in the course. We will then finish the day with a punting tour of the Cambridge Colleges. Students will be expected to catch up with work covered in other subjects during their absence.

We will be leaving school at 7.50am, travelling by minibus and returning at approximately 5pm. Students need to bring a packed lunch with them or sufficient money to purchase a lunch during the day. Students need to wear appropriate clothes and shoes for walking and speaking to members of the public.

Your child will be insured under the normal arrangements for school visits. It is advised that students do not take valuables on this trip. However, if necessary, please ensure that your own insurance or any that has been published as coming with the visit covers such items. Please consent and pay via parentpay (<a href="www.parentpay.com">www.parentpay.com</a>). The suggested per student contribution is £24 to cover the cost of transport and punting and is required by Friday 27 September. In order for the trip to go ahead, it is essential that sufficient voluntary contributions are received to cover the full cost. Please note that once you have committed to a trip all deposits and monies paid will be non-refundable should your child withdraw from the trip.
